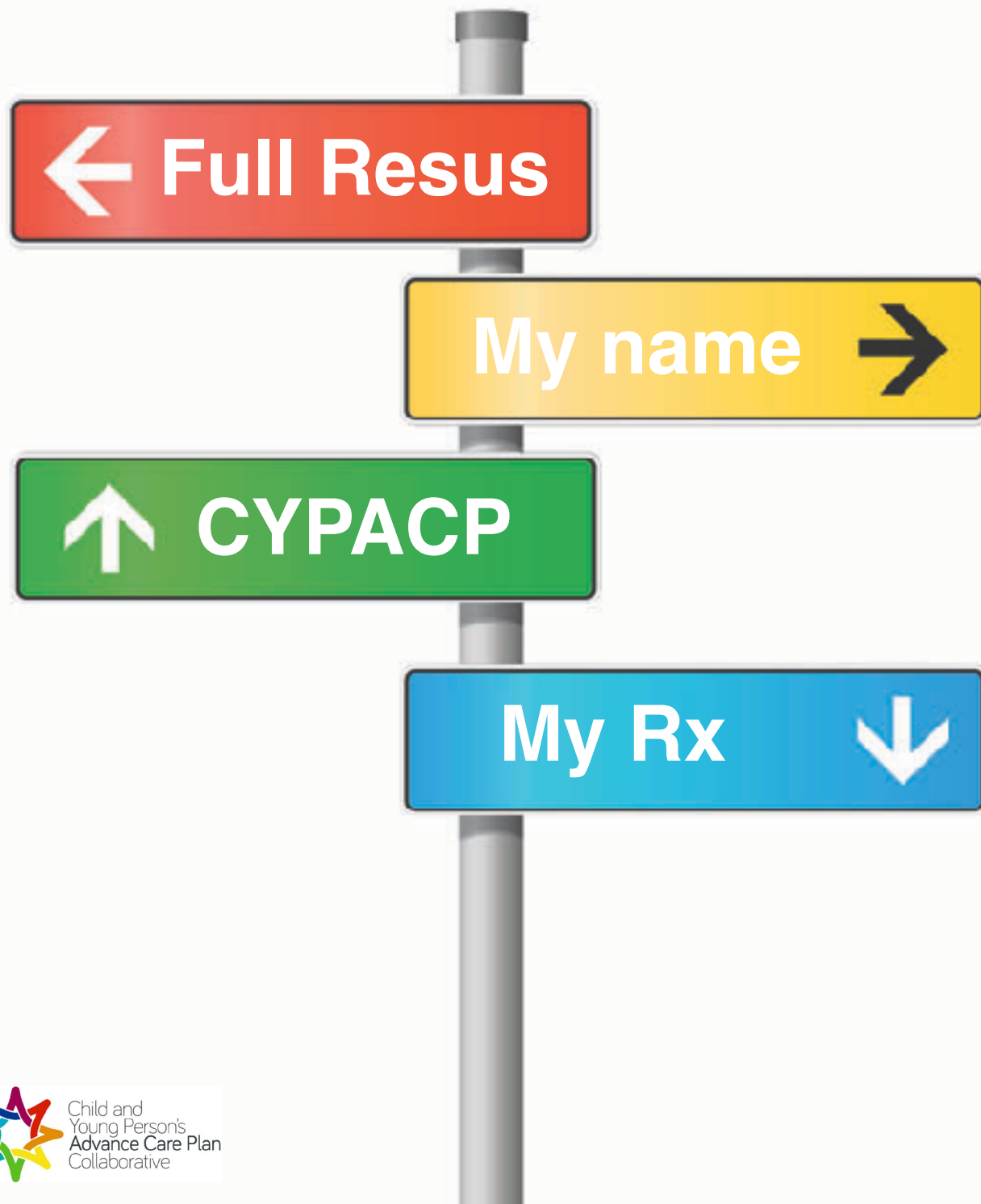

Summary

- If appropriate and if time allows, use advance care planning to inform content of the **ReSPECT** form
- Make shared decisions for the current situation
- Work through **ReSPECT** systematically to establish
 - the background to the recommendations
 - the parent's preferences for care and treatment
 - agreed clinical recommendations
- Complete page 2 fully to confirm the validity of the plan
